Contemporary artist Vincenzo Nasuto has created interpretations of works by great Italian Renaissance masters - Leonardo da Vinci, Raffaello Sanzio (Raphael), Perugino and Luca Signorelli - in a collection of scarves. From 5 to 23 May 2023, to mark the 500th anniversary of the deaths of these renowned artists between 1520 and 1523, the Museo del Mar de Santa Pola is holding an exhibition to celebrate the history of art's best-known period, the Renaissance.

The Renaissance artist and scientist Leonardo da Vinci died in 1520 appears on Vincenzo Nasuto's scarves, revisited through his experiments and women with messy hair, his atmospheres, innovations, and secular revolutions.

Raffaello Sanzio, another brilliant Renaissance artist, is present with the sweet, delicate figures that marked his artistic style and that influenced artists in subsequent periods and artistic currents.

Finally, in 2023 we honour Pietro Vannucci, known as Il Perugino, master of Raphael and Luca Signorelli, important artists who worked on the frescos in the Sistine Chapel.

Captivating angels, mythical figures and self-portraits captivate in an exhibition where the artist Vincenzo Nasuto, through his interpretations of great Renaissance works of art, making great works a tangible, active part of modern life.
